Celebrini became the youngest player in history to win the Hobey Baker Award as the NCAA's Top Player, posting 32 goals and 64 points in 38 games as a 17-year-old playing against athletes who were up to 8 years older than him. His intelligence carries him through all phases of the game, showing exceptional reads at both ends of the ice, and can maximize his reads with elite offensive touch. Celebrini can skate, shoot, pass, play with skill, and has all the makings of a top-line NHL center.

SCOUTING REPORT: The most skilled player in the class, Demidov is another super talent coming out of Russia fresh off the heels of Matvei Michkov in 2023. Despite not being in the top slot, Demidov has arguably the highest offensive ceiling of any player in this draft. He's a dynamic and creative attacker with a set of hands that are elite as it gets, allowing him to slip through tight gaps in coverage and work into high-danger scoring areas. Capable as a scorer, but excels particularly as a playmaker with a skill set that led to a 37 assist, 60 point season in 30 games played, earning him MVP honors in the MHL.

SCOUTING REPORT: The son of Calgary Flames legend Jarome Iginla, Tij is a high-motor forward who looks poised to fill nets in the NHL just like his father did. Iginla's a natural goal scorer who can contribute in a number of ways, showing high-end small area skill that allows him to score in close while also having a strong shot that allows him to beat goalies from range as well. SCOUTING REPORT: Buium is a smooth and intelligent defenseman who's coming off a National Championship with Denver this past season. Buium was a massive part of the Pioneers title run, with a package that includes smooth four-way mobility, poise with the puck on his stick, and advanced offensive vision that allowed him to post the highest-scoring season by a draft-eligible defenseman in NCAA history with 50 points in 42 games. Evangelists of Silayev's game will point out two key selling points: his size mixed with his skating.
